#### HIGH QUALITY SOUND AND PICTURE

#### 96 kHz/24 bit audio D/A converter

This player enables 96 kHz/24 bit linear PCM signals, which constitute the highest specifications in the DVD standards, to be reproduced faithfully. To support 96 kHz sampling/24 bit sound, the shaping noise of this multi-level digital sigma type of D/A converter is kept flat up to 44 kHz, thus preventing the important audio signals from being affected in any way. In terms of the bottom line, the sound in all of its various modes is reproduced faithfully.

The player can play back discs with signal system of PAL and NTSC.

#### GRAPHICAL USER INTERFACE SCREEN

Simply by pressing the OSD button on the remote control unit, information on the player and disc can be displayed on the TV screen for easy identification, The player's operations and settings can easily be performed by operating the remote control while monitoring the TV screen.

#### MULTI-AUDIO FUNCTION

The audio soundtrack can be heard in up to 8 languages. (The number of audio sound languages depends on the software.)

#### MULTI-SUBTITLES FUNCTION

Subtitles may be displayed in one of a maximum of 32 languages depends on the software.

#### MULTI-ANGLE FUNCTION

This function allows you to choose the viewing angle of scenes which were shot from a number of different angles. (Limited to DVD recorded with multiple camera angles.)

#### PARENTAL LOCK FUNCTION

This can prevent play of DVD unsuitable for children.

#### Power Cord Protection

In order to avoid any malfunctions of the units, electric shock, fire or personal injury, please to observe the following: -Hold the plug firmly when you connecting or disconnecting the AC power cord to this unit.

- -Do not connect or disconnect the AC power cord when your hands are wet.
- -Keep the AC power cord away from heating appliances.
- -Never put the heavy object on the AC power cord.
- -Do not attempt to repair or reconstruct the AC power cord in any way.

#### Placement

Avoid to place the unit in the areas of:

- direct sunlight or heating radiators, or dosed automobiles
- high temperature (over 35°C) or high humidity (over 90%)
- Much dust
- vibration, impact or where the surface is tilted as the internal parts may be damaged seriously

#### Non-use periods

When the unit is not being used, turn the power off.

When you left unused for a long period of time, the unit should be unplugged from the household AC outlet.

### No fingers or other objects inside

If there is noise interference on the TV while a broadcast is being received





# Basic connection

- 1. If your TV has an RCA (Audio and video) input panel, connect the unit to the TV set with the supplied audio/video connecting cable. Set the TV to AV mode when connection is completed and confirmed correctly. (1)
- 2.In the event that your TV has an S-VIDEO input socket, connecting the DVD player with a S-VIDEO connecting cable (optional). It will give you a slightly better quality picture. (2)
- 3.If your TV has a component video input panel (also known as colour different input), connect the DVD component output to corresponding input sockets on your TV. It will give you a picture of best quality. (3)
- 4. If your TV has a SCART socket, connect a fully wired SCART cable between the player and the TV. Scart will produce a picture better than a S-VIDEO connection. (4)
- 5. If your TV/Amplifier has a HDMI socket, connecti a fully wired HDMI cable between the player and the TV/Amplifer. It will produce the best quality of picture and audio.(5)
- 6. If your Amplifier/Effector has XLR socket, connect a fully wired XLR cable between the player and the Amplifier/Effector. It is Audio balanced output of karaoke.(6)
- 7. The "karaoke out" socket's function is as well as XLR socket.(7).

#### Notes:

Connection terminal of back panel

According to the optional connections above, we list 4 methods of the connection with the TV set.

- 1. Composite video connection with 2 audio channels. (Please switch the TV set to AV mode)
- S-VIDEO connection. This solution provides a better picture definition. Audio can be connected in the same way as
  option 1 with a pair of RCA (phono) leads connected to either the TV or external amplifier. (Please switch the TV and the
  player to S-VIDEO mode)
- 3. Progressive and chromatic component connection. This connection provides the best quality picture. Audio can be connected in the same way as option I with a pair of RCA (phono) leads connected to either the TV or external amplifier. (Please switch TV set and the player to P-scan YUV or Interlace-YUV mode.)
- 4. SCART is for you to connect to player to TV, please switch the video output to SCART mode from player.
- HDMI(High Definition Multimedia Interface) could be output the resolution of 1920x1080 and 5.1 sound track if the disc could support.
- 6. XLR (MIXED OUT) is for karaoke use.
- 7. KARAOKE OUT RCA's are for karaoke use.

#### NOTE:

Before making any connections, ensure that both of the player and the TV are switched off:

Adjusting the output of the player to suit the system of your TV (PAL Standard TV / NTSC More advanced TV's);

Only select one connection option to avoid the TV mixing signals and reducing quality and interference;

Do not turn the unit on and off rapidly. Allow at least 10 seconds for the system to boot up before you turning it off again; Do not connect digital audio output sockets or optical fibre sockets to the analogue input of any amplifier.

It may damage it;

Don't connect Component Video Output, S-video output, SCART-output to the TV at the same time, or else the quality of the image would deteriorate.

# Remote control unit operation

#### Battery installation

Insert the batteries while observing the correct (+) and (-) polarities as illustrated at right.

#### Service life of batteries

- The batteries normally last for about one year although this depends on how often, and for what operations, the remote control unit is used.
- If the remote control unit fails to work even when it is operated near the player, replace the batteries.
   Use 2 size AAA batteries.

#### Note:

- . Do not use rechargeable (Ni-Cd) batteries.
- Do not attempt to recharge, short-circuit, disassemble, heat or throw te batteries into the fire.
- Do not drop, step on or otherwise impact the remote control unit. This may damage the parts or lead to malfunction
- . Do not mix old and new batteries.
- If the remote control unit is not going to be used for a long time, remove the batteries. Otherwise, electrolyte may leak which may lead not only to malfunctioning but also to burns if contact is made with the electrolyte.
- Wipe away any electrolyte leaking inside the remote control unit, and install new batteries.
- If any electrolyte should come into contact with parts of your body, wash it off thoroughly with water.

# Remote control operation range E

Point the remote control unit from no more than about 3-4 m from the remote control sensor and within about  $60^\circ$  of the front of the player.


 The operating distance may vary according to the brightness of the room.

#### Note:

- . Do not point bright lights at the remote control sensor.
- Do not place objects between the remote control unit and the remote control sensor.
- Do not use this remote control unit while simultaneously operating the remote control unit of any other equipment.

# **Connecting Microphones**

- 1. Connect the Microphones.
  - Connect one or two Microphones to MIC 1 or MIC 2 inputs (front panel).
- Adjust the MIC Volume to Proper level that you want before enjoying DVD/Video CD/CD. You can also adjust microphone(s) effects for your own taste.



# **Basic operation**

Before enjoying DVD/Video CD/CD

If you would like to change the menu language to other language, please refer to "Selecting language of On-Screen Display menu".

In the explanation given below it is assumed that English has been selected as the menu language.

#### Stopping play

Press STOP

For your convenience:

When player is stopped, the player records the point where STOP was pressed (RESUME function). Press PLAY again, playback will resume from this point. When STOP is pressed again,

the RESUME function will be cleared.

#### **Basic Play**

Preparations

Switch the TV On and selec "Video" as the TV input. Switch on the stereo system's power if the player has been connected to a stereo system.

#### Basic play

- 1. Press POWER to switch on the power.
- 2. Press Open/Close to open the disc tray.
- Place a disc onto the disc tray. Hold the disc without touching either of its surfaces, position it with the printed title side facing up, alight it with the guides, and place it in its proper position.
- 4. Press Open/Close
  - The disc tray is automatically closed and play begins. When the disc tray is closed by pressing OPEN/CLOSE the player will start to read the disc automatically.
- When a menu screen appears on the TV, move the navigation buttons or press numeric buttons to select preferred track number, then press ENTER button to confirm.
- When the menu continues onto another screen, press NEXT button to view the next screen, or press PREV. to skip to the previous screen.
  - NOTE: Due to the different design of some software titles, NEXT/PREV button may not always work.
- To stop play and return to the menu screen press TITLE button, or MENU button (which button is pressed differs depending on the disc used).

For DVD, press TITLE, MENU or RETURN. For VCD, press RETURN.

# Skipping ahead or back

Skipping ahead

Press NEXT button durin play.

A chapter (DVD) or a track (VCD/CD) is skipped forward each time the button is pressed.

Skipping back

Press PREV. button during play.

A chapter (DVD) or a track (VCD/CD) is skipped backward each time the button is pressed

#### Fast forward/ reverse

Press NEXT button (DOWN) to fast forward. Each press will change the speed to 2X--4X--8X--16X--32X.

Press PREV. button (DOWN) to fast reverse. Each press will change the speed to 2X--4X--8X--16X--32X.

Press PLAY to return normal play mode.

### Step play

During playback, press STEP button, the play will be paused, and in this mode, each time the STEP button is pressed, the player will only play one picture. To resume normal play, press PLAY button.

# **Basic operation**

#### Slow-motion play (DVD/VCD)

On the remote control unit Press SLOW button durin playback. Play the disc at a ½ of normal speed at first, each time the button is pressed, the play speed becomes slower (1/2,1/4,1/81/16). Press PLAY button, normal play will resume.

#### MP3/MPEG4 playback

#### Basic play

- Insert the disc containing the files in MP3 format to be played and after few minutes, the TV screen will show all folders on the disc.
- Select the folder you want to play by the navigation buttons and press ENTER button to confirm.
- The files in this folder are displayed and select your song by using the UP/DOWN navigation buttons and press ENTER button to start playback.
- Press NEXT button to play next sound or PREV. button to play previous.
- Press REPEAT button on remote to change play mode.

#### **USB** play Mode

- 1. Insert the USB/Card into the USB/Card slot.
- Press the SOURCE (depends which one is inserted) button and use UP/DOWN button to choose USB or Card, the TV screen will display the information of the USB or Card.
   After few minutes, the TV screen will show all folders in
- the USB/Card.

  4. Select the folder you want by the payingtion buttons and
- Select the folder you want by the navigation buttons and press OK button to confirm.
- The files in this folder are displayed and you can select your song by using the UP/DOWN navigation buttons. and press OK button to start playing.
- Press NEXT button to play the next or PREV. button to play previously.
- 7. Press REPEAT button on remote to change play mode.

Remark: If you want to play DVD disc when you are in USB/Card mode, just press SOURCE button and choose DVD.The playing will stop, change from USB/Card to DVD disc.

#### Enjoying Video CDs with playback control

When playing VCD 2.0 with PBC, use PBC button. The player will show

PBC on

Press PBC button once, the player will show PBC off

When the PBC is ON (menu play),

- Press numeric button to select corresponding track, if the track number is under 10, choose one of the numeric buttons 0-9.
- If the track number is exceed 10, press +10 button first, then press numeric buttons 0-9.
- 3. During playback, and the PBC is ON, press RETURN button to main menu.
- Press NEXT button or PREV. button, the player will play in the scheduled sequence on the disc.

#### Karaoke operation

- 1. Connect microphones to microphone jacks.
- Turn microphones volume to minimun (Mic vol. Knobs 1-2)
- 3. Power on the unit and play a Karaoke disc.
- Turn on the microphones and adjust the microphones volume (Mic vol. Knobs) to proper level you wanted.

Note: If you hold the microphones too close or direction towards the speakers, howling may occur. In order to prevent it, please don't hold the microphones too close or direction towards the speakers. Adjust the microphones volume to a proper position.

- Press AUDIO button to cancel vocal sound in DVD (depends on disc)
- Press L/R button to cancel vocal sound in VCD (depends on disc)

Press Start to start Program Play.

2. Press navigation buttons to choose memory index and then press the desired Titles/Chapters number by using the numeric buttons. The selected Titles and Chapters are stored into the memory. Up to 20 memories can be stored.

NOTE: Leading zero is not necessary. If the track number is more than 10, press the +10 key first and then unit digit.

Examples: Track 3, press "3" Track 12, press "+10" then "2" Track 21, press "+10" twice then "1"

- 3. To start program play, select start on the menu or select exit to exit without program play.
- 4. To Clear "Program" during program play Press PROGRAM key, then press CLEAR key to clear program.
- For CD/MP3

Press PROGRAM key, all files or tracks will appear on the screen. Use the navigation UP/DOWN key to select the file or track, then press the Navigation Right Key to add to the playlist or use the Navigation Left Key to remove the selected file or track from the playlist. After program, press the PROGRAM key to the playlist and start the program play.

### Repeat Play

Press REPEAT button during play, it will repeat play one chapter or one title (for DVD), or repeat play track (for VCD/CD).

### A-B Repeat play

- Press A-B button during play at the point where repeat play is to be started (A)
- Press A-B button at the point where repeat play is to be ended (B). Repeat play of the selection between points A and B starts.
- 3. Press A-B button to return to normal play.

# Changing Subtitle language (DVD only)

It is possible to change the subtitle language to a different language from the one selected at the initial settings. (This operation works only with discs on which multiple subtitle languages are recorded.)

- Press SUBTITLE button during play, the screen will display hte current language.
- Press SUBTITLE button again to change language or turn off.

NOTE: When no subtitles are recorded, pressing this button will not work.

#### **ZOOM PLAY**

This function allow you to enjoy a motion or motionless picture.

### Changing audio soundtrack language (DVD/VCD

It is possible to change the audio soundtrack language to a different language from the once selected at the initial settings. (This operation works only with discs on which multiple audio soundtrack languages are recorded)

Press LANGUAGE button during DVD disc, the screen will display the number of current soundtrack language, pressing button again will change the language.

#### For VCD disc

NOTE: When no soundtrack languages are recorded, pressing this button will not work.

### Viewing from different angles (DVD only)

Some DVDs may contain scenes which have been shot simultaneously from a number of different angles. For these discs, the same scene can be views from each of these different angles by using the ANGLE button.

Press ANGLE during play, number of angle being playback will be displayed in the screen, pressing the button will change to different angles.

### Kodak Picture CD / JPEG CD

If Kodak Picture CD is inserted, slide show is began automatically.

For JPEG picture CD, select the folder you want to play by the navigation buttons and press SELECT button to confirm.

These files in this folder are displayed. Select your favorite pictures by using the up/down navigation buttons and press SELECT button to start playback.

# Initial settings

Once the initial programmin is entered it is retained in memory until changed, the player can always be operated under the same conditions.



# **Definition of terms**

#### Angle

Recorded onto some DVD discs are scenes which have been simultaneously shot from a number of different angles (the same scene is shot from the front, from the left side, from the right side, etc.). With such discs, the ANGLE button can be used to view the scene from different angles.

#### Chapter number

These numbers are recorded on DVD discs. A title is subdivided into many sections, each of which is numbered, and specific parts of video presentations can be searched quickly using these numbers.

#### DVD/Divx

This refers to a high-density optical disc on which high-quality pictures and sound have been obtained by means of digital signals. Incorporation a new video compression technology (MPEG II) and high-density recording technology, DVD enables esthetically pleasing full-motion video to be recorded over long periods of time (for instance, a whole movie can be recorded).

DVD has a structure consisting of two 0.6 mm thin discs which are adhered to each other. Since the thinner the disc, the higher the density at which the information can be recorded, a DVD disc has a greater capacity than a single 1.2 mm thick disc. Since the two thin discs are adhered to each other, there is the potential to achieve double-sided play sometime in the future for even longer duration play.

#### Playback control (PBC)

This is recorded on a Video CD (version 2.0). The scenes or information to be viewed (or listened to) can be selected interactively with the TV monitor by looking at the menu shown on the TV monitor.

#### Subtitles

This is the appearance of the dialogue at the bottom of the screen which are prerecorded on some DVD discs.

#### Time number

This indicates the play time which has elapsed from the start of a disc or a title. It can be used to find a specific scene quickly.(It may not work with some discs.)

#### Title number

These numbers are recorded on DVD discs. When a disc contains two or more movies, these movies are numbered as title 1. title 2. etc.

#### Track number

These numbers are assigned to the tracks which are recorded on Video CDs and CDs. They enable specific tracks to be located quickly.

### Video CD

This contains recordings of pictures and sound whose quality is on a par with that of videotape. This player also supports Video CDs with playback control (version 2.0).

# Disc handling and maintenance

#### Handling precautions

- · Hold the disc by the edges so the surface will not be soiled with fingerprints.
- Fingerprints, dirt and scratches can cause skipping and distortion.
- Do not write on the label side with a ball-point pen or other writing utensils.
- · Do not use record cleaning sprays, benzine, thinner, static electricity prevention liquids or bend the disc.
- . Be careful not to drop or bend the disc.
- · Do not install more than 1 disc on the disc tray.
- · Do not try to close the disc tray when the disc is not installed properly.
- · Be sure to store the disc in its exclusive case when not in use.

#### If the surface is soiled

Wipe gently with a soft, damp (water only) cloth.

When wiping discs, always move the cloth from the centre hole toward the edge.)

(If you wipe the discs using a circular motion, circular scratches are likely to occur, which will cause noise.)

#### If the disc is brought from a cold to a warm environment moisture may form on the disc

Wipe this moisture off with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth before using the disc.

#### Improper disc storage

You can damage discs if you store them in the following places:

- · Areas exposed to direct sunlight
- · Humid or dusty areas
- · Areas directly exposed to a heat outlet or heating appliance

#### Maintenance

- Be sure to press POWER to set the player to the standby mode and disconnect the AC power cord before maintaining the player.
- · Wipe this player with a dry, soft cloth.
- If the surfaces are extremely dirty ,wipe clean with a cloth which has been dipped in a weak soap-and-water solution and wrung out thoroughly, and then wipe again with a dry cloth.
